First Aid Point

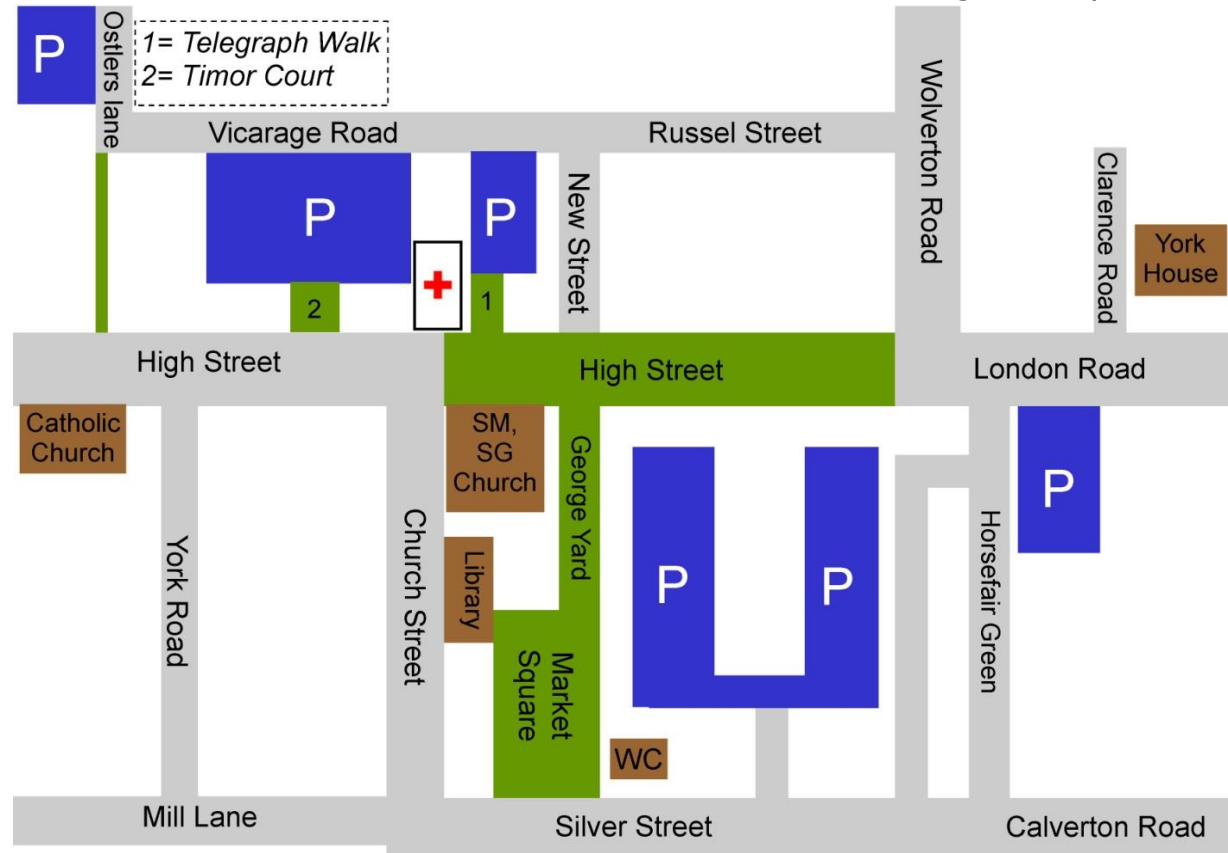
The First Aid Point will be located in The Bull Hotel along the High Street
