- 09/097 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: The chairman reminded all members of the requirements of the Code of Conduct. There were no declarations of interest
- 09/098 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE: Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr Hilary Coley. Regrets were received from MK Cllr Phil Wharton
- 09/099 MINUTES OF MEETINGS DATED 19 MAY 2009: as previously circulated were **AGREED as a true record and signed (DT/AD)**
- 09/100 CLERK'S REPORT: The clerk's report was **NOTED**. It was **AGREED** that the response from the working group with regards the proposed back cover of the Stony Stratford Design Guide was acceptable
- 09/101 CHRISTINE CHAPMAN MBE: The Council **AGREED** to record its congratulations to Christine Chapman on the award of an MBE in the Queen's Birthday Honours List
- 09/102 STONY STRATFORD AREA TRAFFIC REVIEW: Members **NOTED** the results of the consultation questionnaire, the draft minutes of the follow-up meeting and the resident's letter

With regards the Western Expansion Area, the Council **AGREED** to reiterate its previous position that the WEA should have its own parish and to support the convening of a meeting of neighbouring parishes to discuss further

- 09/120 GRANT APPLICATION - MK YOUTH SERVICE: It was **AGREED** to grant £960 towards the cost of the project as requested
- 09/121 GRANT APPLICATION - ROWANS CHILDREN CENTRE: The application was discussed and a proposal to grant £400 failed to gain a seconder. A vote was taken on the original request and, with 6 votes for and 2 votes against, it was **AGREED** to grant £1000 towards the project as requested.

- 09/123 WILLEN HOSPICE: It was **AGREED** to respond (i) that the Town Council had already granted funding to Stony Open Gardens which was a fund raiser for the hospice (ii) that a cheque for £200 would be sent to the hospice to be used to promote fund raising activities in the parish and (iii) that the hospice be advised of the Council's newsletter and the opportunity that this provided for the hospice to publicise its needs
