SUSTAINABLE WARMTH GRANT

ARE YOU STRUGGLING TO KEEP YOUR HOME WARM?

DO YOU NEED FUNDING TO HELP INSTALL INSULATION AND OTHER ENERGY SAVING MEASURES?

Sustainable Warmth is a Government **Grant of up to £10,000** to fund energy-efficiency measures for residents of Milton Keynes who are most likely to be impacted by the high cost of rising bills.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE GRANT IF:

- Your household income is no more than £30,000 (before tax or any other deductions).
- After you have paid your rent or mortgage your income is below £20,000.
- The number of people living in your household stretches your income so you are in fuel poverty.
- Your home has an EPC rating of E, F or G.

WARM HOME DISCOUNT SCHEME

You could get £150 off your electricity bill for winter 2022 to 2023 under the Warm Home Discount Scheme. The money is not paid to you - it's a one-off discount on your electricity bill, between October 2022 and March 2023.

WINTER FUEL PAYMENT

If you were born before 26 September 1956 you could get between £250 and £600 to help you pay your heating bills. This is known as a 'Winter Fuel Payment'.
