£12,000 - contribution towards the Stony Stratford Town Council and Milton Keynes Council commissioned Parking and Traffic Review

£5,000 – Stony Stratford contribution towards the new equipment at Calverton End Play Park

 $\pounds 5,000$ – Stony Stratford contribution towards the new picnic benches, information board, bunding and height restriction at Mortimer Park
